Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures:

Our hours of operation are 6:30 am to 6:30 pm. Children should be picked up by 6:15 pm. This permits staff to clean and prepare the classrooms for the next school day before the staff leaves for the day. Our staff is scheduled to close - 6:30 pm.

Late pick up Fees will be applied if a child/ren is/are picked up later than 6:30 pm. The Late Pick Up Fee is a minimum of \$20.00 per child if pick up is between 6:30 pm and 6:40 pm by our clock. There is a \$2.00 a minute fee applied for every minute after 6:40 pm.



Our Continuing Disinfecting and Sanitizing Effort

We complete a thorough deep cleaning of all classrooms and contents by an assigned weekly cleaning schedule. Every single toy, bin, shelf, chair, table, light switch, door handle, wall, other hard surface, and soft surface is disinfected.

We have hired a new cleaning company to support our our rigorous cleaning and disinfecting protocol which is designed to keep the spread of germs to a minimum.



Current Illness Policy:

If your child has a fever or shows signs of illness, please do not send them to school. Consult your child's physician to be certain they are well and can return to school.

Children should be kept home until they are <u>fever free</u> - <u>without the use of medications - for 24 hours</u> and/ or do not show signs of illness. We will require a doctor's note confirming your child can return to school.

The use of all over the counter fever reducer medication will not be permitted during this time.

If your child has ANY fever or shows signs of illness while at school, they will be sent home.

If your child has been sent home due to fever or illness, a doctor's note is required for return.



Our Illness Policy also applies to our staff to ensure everyone's health/ safety.

The children have been taught to sneeze into their elbow, wipe/ blow their noses, and the importance of frequent hand washing is repeated often. All are reminded to wash hands throughout the day.
