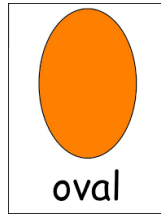


Below is a breakdown of the monthly focus. To continue the extension of learning at home you can practice using the sign language word and point out the colors and shapes in your child's world.

What you'll need:

- cardboard
- white paint & brushes (optional)
- yarn in desired colors, we used white + blues and whites + rainbow.
- facial features – googly eyes, yarn (optional)
- pom-pom maker (optional)
- scissors
- pencil
- a little glue (depending on which yarn wrapped cloud you make)

Directions:

- Take your cardboard and roughly sketch out a cloud.
- Cut out your cloud.
- If you wish paint your cardboard white (or grey or blue or pink).
- Cut some little "nicks" all around your cloud, to help position your yarn as you go around.
- Tie a piece of yarn to the cloud and start wrapping.

For the rainbow, we used some left-over card and cut out a long thin rectangle, a little shorter than the cloud is wide.

Then cut approximately 60cm strands of yarn:

- 4 reds
- 4 oranges
- 4 yellows
- 4 greens
- 4 blues
- 4 purples

Fold the yarn in half to make a loop at one end.

Place the loop under the thing rectangle.

Push the two loose ends through the loop and tighten. To make a simple knot!

Repeat with all the colors.

Trim if you wish!
