All children ages 2 to 5 years will be "tested" one-on-one with the teacher to gather an assessment of their overall comprehension. The assessments will be shared with you at the beginning of May. Our assessments are comprised of knowledge evaluations, anecdotal notes and work samples. These items help us create an overall understanding of your child's growth. During these conferences we will discuss what areas of development your child needs to work on and what they have mastered in the past year. In late April you will see a message come to you that gives you the date and times available for the upcoming Parent-Teacher Conference to discuss the results of our assessments. If you are unable to attend these phone conferences on the established date, or you would like an in-person conference, please let management know so that we can schedule it for a later date.

CHILD ASSESSMENTS

APRIL 1ST—26TH

Early education assessments of developmental milestones and skill ability are supported and expected of quality early learning programs. Associations such as Cognia incorporate early learning assessments into their accreditation standards. The company Teaching Strategies lists four major purposes of assessments in early learning environments: "to support learning, to identify special needs, to evaluate programs and monitor trends, and to respond to program and school accountability requirements". Additionally, Texas Child Care lists "Observation & Assessments" as a category of training in Minimum Standards for Child Care Centers.

All assessments are designed to be done through observation of individual activities over the time the child is in the classroom. Teachers choose one skill on the assessment form and observe each child during causal classroom time, outdoor time, and/or during lesson activities. Teachers are encouraged to take simple notes during observations regarding the progression level of each child and log the results on each child's assessment form. After we have completed the full assessment, we invite parents to join us for a conference where we discuss our observations. This is a great opportunity to set goals for the next school year.
