Character Value For The Month: Responsibility

Whether your child is enrolled in our full day Virtual Learning program or our Before & Afterschool program, he/she will be participating in our new School-Age **Quest** Curriculum.

With the **Quest** curriculum, the children can choose different challenges in a variety of S.T.E.A.M. based interest areas including science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics. After they complete their chosen challenge, they will receive a cog (similar to a badge). These challenges can be done individually, with a partner, outdoors or even within the community. The children will continue to receive cogs as they complete challenges daily.

The **Quest** curriculum includes an emphasis on character values and community service. The curriculum develops critical and higher level thinking skills while having a strong outdoors component.
