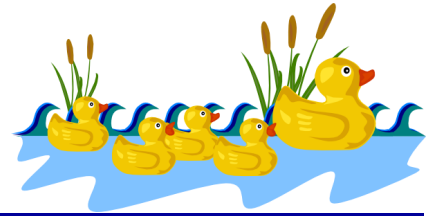
Infants & Young Toddlers Curriculum Overview: Rooms 1, 2, 3

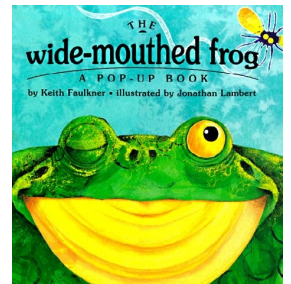

We will begin construction of our new splash pad during the month of April! Our splash pad will be a state of the art space with lots of fun ways to get soaked throughout the warm months!




