Directors' Corner...

Happy Holidays! It is hard to believe, but December has arrived and the time for fun holiday festivities is here! We are looking forward to seeing each of you at Winter Wonderland on December 7th, complete with face painting, snow, games, and a visit from Santa!

With the holidays upon us, we wanted to take a moment to refresh our policy regarding Absentee Credits. We offer 5 weeks per year of Absentee Credits for all children, age 13 months and above, who are enrolled in full-time care and are absent for three consecutive days in any given week, not including holidays. Absentee Credits offer a 40% discount off of the weekly tuition and must be submitted in advance. If your family is not currently on automatic payments, then payment for the week of the Absentee Credit must be paid in full when the request is submitted. Please stop by the front office if you would like an Absentee Credit form for any of the weeks over the Christmas holiday.

With the cooler weather, we wanted to send a reminder to label all items such as jackets, hats, and mittens. Each child often brings multiple items and they can become misplaced during the hustle of drop offs and pick ups. Please take extra caution to check the name on any item you take home, and know that while we try our best to keep track of all items, we are not responsible for anything that may be accidentally taken by another family.

We also want to share that we have been having an increase in requests made by parents to have teachers change children into clothing/uniforms in the afternoons for extra curricular activities, and we would want to request that parents make arrangements that allow them to change their own children when they arrive, as our bathrooms are always available. This ensures that our teachers are able to focus on supervision of the classroom and implementing the required elements of our program at all times. Please let us know if you have any questions.
