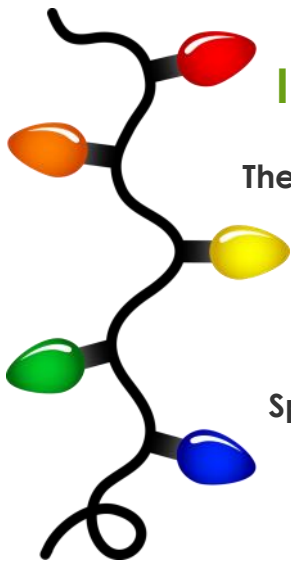


ROOMS 1 & 2

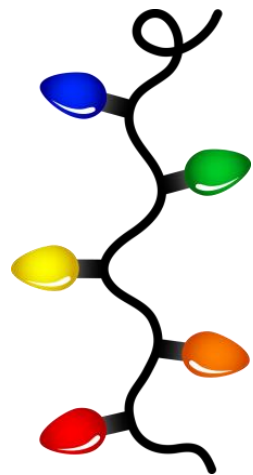
Hello Parents!
