Solo Challenge: Marble Drop

Let's see how strong paper can be! When you examine paper closely, you will notice the tiny fibers. Think about how many fibers are in a coffee filter, a paper towel, and a tissue. In this Challenge, you will test these paper items by stacking wet marbles on top of them. You will witness how well the fibers handle the weight of the marbles. Are you ready to find out how tough paper really is?

Gather four Questers for this Challenge. Start by placing a coffee filter on top of a cup and secure it with a rubber band, like in the example photo. Take turns adding marbles to the coffee filter, seeing how many it can hold before breaking. Count the marbles in the cup when it breaks, then put them back in the container. Record your results on the Marble Drop graph. Repeat this for the tissue and the paper towel.
