The month of February brings with it a wonderful opportunity to celebrate love, friendship, and kindness.

Reminders:

ATTENTION FEBRUARY BIRTHDAYS: If your child has a well visit this month and receives vaccines, please bring in an updated copy of those shots. Thank you!

Please do not have your child bring personal toys/items from home. A lovey to be snuggled during naptime us absolutely ok, but we are asking for all other items to stay in the car/at home. We have had an increase in personal toys being brought into the classrooms and they have been causing distractions during learning time as well as conflict amongst peers.

We are also asking that children not bring backpacks to school each day. Each child has a cubby and a hook for personal items but we have found that backpacks are more challenging to monitor, since they are at children's level. If your child needs to bring a personal bag because they are going home with someone else at the end of the day, we are happy to store those bags up front until your child is picked up. *Please note: this does not apply to Rooms 1, 2, and 10.

Sick season is here! Please take the extra few minutes to wash your child's hands when you drop them off. This extra attention is a great step and reenforces the teachings of handwashing throughout the day. If you are called about your child having a fever, multiple occurrences of diarrhea, vomiting, or other conditions listed in our Wellness Policy, please make arrangements to pick them up within one hour of the call.

As the weather transitions from winter to spring (sometimes all in one day) please ensure that your child comes in proper attire. Layers are the perfect Texas way to dress this time of year! (Just be sure that all layers are labeled!)

Double check your child's cubby to ensure that they have three complete changes of clothes available. Even for children who are potty trained, accidents do happen and sometimes changes of clothes are needed for other reasons as well. If your child is potty training, please make sure they have an extra pair of shoes in their cubby.



free from rash, itching, or fever. I have been evaluated by my doctor if needed.




I HAVE HEAD LICE active head lice, nits, eggs
