Family Activity Hot Chocolate Bombs

Ingredients:

12oz high quality semi-sweet chocolate bars or chips

6tbs of hot chocolate mix

1 cup mini marshmallows

Sprinkles for decoration (optional)

6 cups whole 2% milk

Items needed:

Measuring cups and spoons

(2) 2-inch silicone sphere molds w/ 6 wells

Large heat proof bowl

4-quart pot

Pastry brush

Small piping bag

What to do:

Set up double boiler: Fill up 4-quart pot halfway with water and set over medium high heat. Place heat proof bowl that fits securely on top of pot without touching the water.

Melt Chocolate: Take your 12oz of chocolate and place it into your bowl. As the chocolate begins to melt, stir it with a silicone spatula to help the chocolate melt and prevent it from burning.

Coat the Molds: Take a tablespoon of chocolate and fill each well. Use the brush to spread the chocolate up the sides, and over the edges of the wells. Let the molds sit at room temperature until the chocolate is hardened. (5 to 15 min) Apply a second coat for a thick and even coat. Let sit at room temperature until completely hardened (15-30 min)

Fill: Fill the wells with 2tbs of chocolate mix and 1tbs of mini marshmallows.

Close: Drizzle 1tbs of chocolate over the filling of the edges. Use a spoon to smooth the chocolate over the filling to completely. Allow to dry at room temperature until completely dry.

Enjoy: Heat 1 cup of milk for each hot chocolate bomb. Pour the hot milk into a mug and add your bomb. Allow it to melt. Stir and enjoy!
