- \*School Age children must be dropped off no later than 7:00am
- \*Breakfast is strictly over at 7:30am including any food brought in.
- \*We suggest having your child present at the center by 8:00am so the older children may partake during the circle time
- \*Our center operates from 6:00am to 6:30pm. Please be mindful when picking up and drop off. We will incur a \$1/minute fee for any pick ups after 6:35pm.
- \*We are a <u>NUT FREE</u> facility so please keep that in mind if you do provide a snack or lunch for your child. Food brought from home must be accompanied by a doctor's note.
- \*Tuition for the current week must be paid in full by the end of business day on *Tuesday*, otherwise, we will incur a \$25 late fee on Wednesday morning and \$10 each day after for any outstanding balances.
- \*Please make sure to check our front door and the lobby TVs for notifications on the on-goings in the center.
- \*Every family must stop by the front desk and update each child's enrollment forms with Ms. Emily, no later than Friday, January 11th. Only new enrollments are excluded.
