Welcome back parents and friends!

We hope that everyone had a fantastic holiday break and we are ready to start the new year in full swing. Below, we would like to go over a few of our guidelines to ensure the safest and most effective environment for all of our children.

*School Age children must be dropped off no later than 7:00am

*Breakfast is strictly over at 7:30am including any food brought in.

*We suggest having your child present at the center by 8:00am so the older children may partake during the circle time

*Our center operates from 6:00am to 6:30pm. Please be mindful when picking up and drop off. We will incur a \$1/minute fee for any pick ups after 6:35pm.

*We are a **NUT FREE** facility so please keep that in mind if you do provide a snack or lunch for your child. Food brought from home must be accompanied by a doctor's note.

*Tuition for the current week must be paid in full by the end of business day on **Tuesday**, otherwise, we will incur a \$25 late fee on Wednesday morning and \$10 each day after for any outstanding balances.

*Please make sure to check our front door and the lobby TVs for notifications on the on-goings in the center.

*We will begin a file audit on all the children's files. So please stay tuned to your email for further information that we may need.

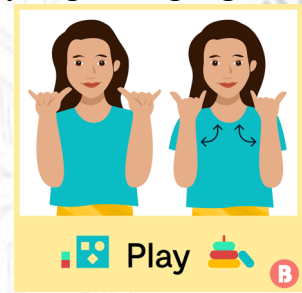
Room 1 Teachers: LaVerne & Ms. Emily

Room 8 Ms. Aisha & Ms. Christi

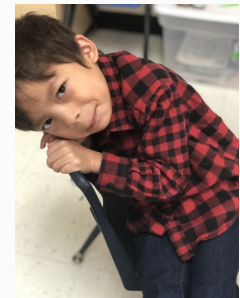
