*School Age children must be dropped off no later than 7:00am

*We suggest having your child present at the center by 8:00am so the older children may partake during the circle time

* No drop off will be allowed pass 9:30am.

*Our center operates from 6:00am to 6:30pm. Please be mindful when picking up and drop off. We will incur a \$1/minute fee for any pick ups after 6:35pm.

*We are a **NUT FREE** facility so please keep that in mind if you do provide a snack or lunch for your child. Food brought from home must be accompanied by a doctor's note.

*Tuition for the current week must be paid in full by the end of business day on **Tuesday**, otherwise, we will incur a \$25 late fee on Wednesday morning and \$10 each day after for any outstanding balances..

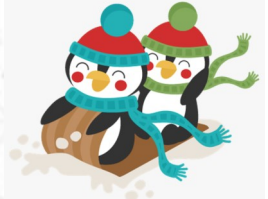
