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Welcome back parents and friends!

We hope that everyone had a fantastic holiday break and we are ready to start the new year in full swing. Below, we would like to go over a few of our guidelines to ensure the safest and most effective environment for all of our children.

For now until further notice we will be doing the Drop Off and Pick Up at the door.

\*School Age children must be dropped off no later than 6:40am, buses leave at 6:50am

\*We suggest having your child present at the center by 8:00am so the older children may partake during the circle time

\* No drop off will be allowed pass 9:30am.

\*Our center operates from 6:00am to 6:30pm. Please be mindful when picking up and drop off. We will incur a \$1/minute fee for any pick ups after 6:30pm.

During bus runs (hrs. 6:50am - 7:30am & 2pm - 4pm) we ask to please leave the front entrance clear of traffic so the kids coming from school get dropped off at the front door.

\*We are a **NUT FREE** facility so please keep that in mind if you do provide a snack or lunch for your child. Food brought from home must be accompanied by a doctor's note.

\*Tuition for the current week must be paid in full by the end of business day on **Tuesday**, otherwise, we will incur a \$25 late fee on Wednesday morning and \$10 each day after for any outstanding balances..

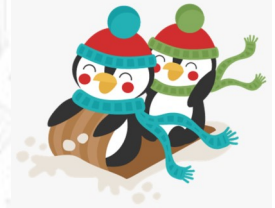


Room 1 Teachers: Ms. LaVerne & Ms. Alex & Ms. Madelynn
