Happy New Year from Room 5!

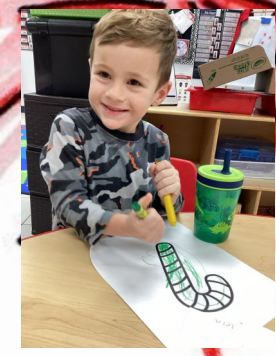

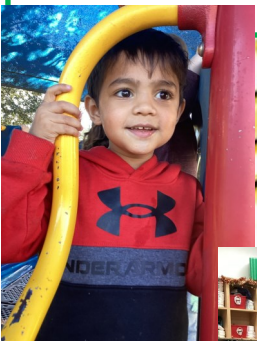
## ROOM 7

body rash with itching  
or fever

free from rash, itching, or

by my doctor if needed.



**I HAVE HEAD LICE**  
active head lice, nits, eggs

treated with appropriate lice  
treatment and cleared of any  
lice, nits, eggs, upon entering



**I HAVE AN EYE INFECTION**  
redness, itching, and/or  
crusty drainage from eye

evaluated by my doctor  
and have a note to return  
to school
