Dear Parents.

At Children's Lighthouse at Grand Mission and WoodCreek Reserve, our commitment to your child's safety is our number one priority. In the past couple of weeks our community have seen an increase in COVID-19 cases. As such, our enhanced sanitation process to ensure your child's and our staff's health and safety continues to be strongly enforced. Additionally, we are requiring all employees to wear face coverings effective Monday, June 22, 2020. We are not requiring children to wear masks at this time.

We also wanted to inform you of our current protocol in the event of a confirmed positive COVID-19 case in our school. Our protocol follows the guidance from the CDC, Fort Bend County Health Department, Texas Health and Human Services (HHS), and our Franchise corporate office. The following steps will take place:

- 1. County health department, HHS and Franchise corporate office will be notified.
- Parents and staff of the affected classroom will be notified by management via a phone-call. The remainder of the school will be notified via email, text or Preschool2me.
- 3. As per CDC guidance, the classrooms visited by the sick individual will be closed for 24 hrs. Windows will be opened and fans left running to circulate fresh air. The entire campus including all outdoor space and play equipment will be disinfected accordingly. Staff will clean and sanitize all toys in the affected classroom with professional grade disinfectant.
- Children and staff in the affected classroom will be required to stay home as recommended by county officials and monitor for any symptoms prior to returning to the school.
- Unaffected classrooms will remain open; however, potential closures of these classrooms will be assessed if additional barriers are deemed necessary.
- 6. The affected individual will not be allowed to return to our facility until:
 - a. at least 72 hours after recovery (resolution of fever without fever-reducing medication),
 - b. have improved respiratory symptoms,
 - c. at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared, and
 - d. provide a negative test for COVID-19

*Please also note that for privacy reasons, and by law, we are not allowed to disclose the name of the individual who may be diagnosed with COVID-19.

If you have any questions or feedback with the above protocols, please do not hesitate to contact our Center Directors. We appreciate your cooperation as we work together in these trying times to protect our children and our community.






