ENROLLMENT PAPERWORK



HOW TRANSITIONS WORK

For those who want to know about how transitions work and what we do to make sure your child is comfortable.

We speak with our families and teachers to determine when the child is ready to move to the next level. After a discussion, we put out a list of children who will move to the next class. At that point, teachers have time to discuss move ups with each other.

After much discussion, an email will be sent out to parents detailing the new classroom, teachers, and when you should expect the transition to occur. At that time, if you have any issues with your child moving classrooms, or you would like to set up time to speak with the teacher, that will be arranged per family request.

We have a schedule for our transtainers, but sometimes we deviate from that schedule. Transitions take at least a week to accomplish. If we see that your child is not doing well, we will speak to you and delay (prolong) the transition. Our end goal is to have your child in the right classroom, and to make sure that they are comfortable in their new setting.

Our Transition Schedule:

Day 1: Parents drop-off in current classroom and child spends 1-2 hours in the morning in the new classroom

Day 2: Parents drop-off in current classroom and child spends all morning in new classroom and will return to old classroom for lunch & nap.

Day 3: Parents drop-off in current classroom and child spends all morning in and all day if child is doing well in new classroom.

Day 4: Parent tries to drop-off in new classroom. If child is not willing, please talk to current teacher or administration.

Day 5: Child is dropped off and remains in new classroom.

This is a simple plan to follow and the best way to help your child move to the next classroom. We hope that this helps shed light on the process and what we do to prepare for your child's move up.
