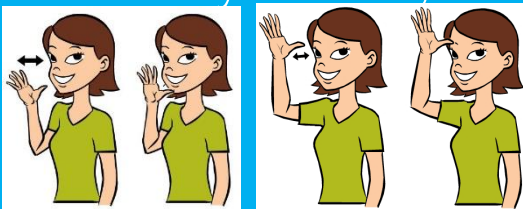

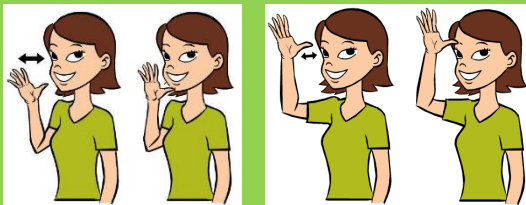

Junior Camp News








