Starts June 10th and 11th

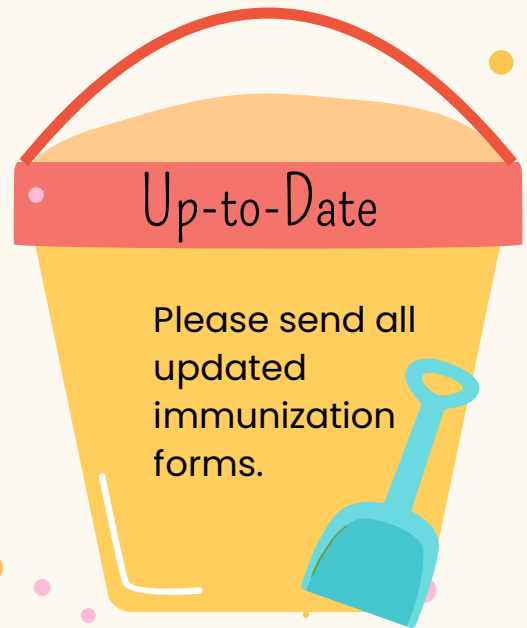
- Sunscreen must be applied before arrival.
