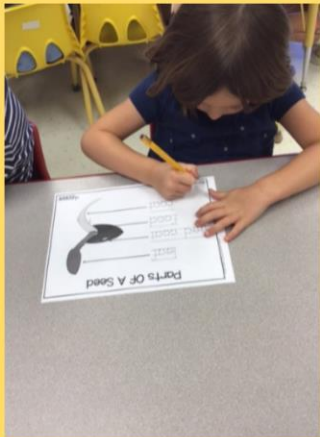
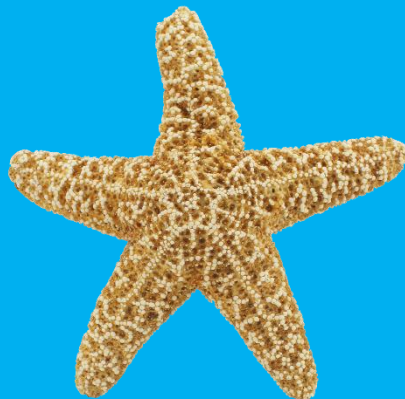
month. Our friends enjoyed watching a few plants and flowers grow and learning about all the components they need to grow! We are ready for fun in the sun!

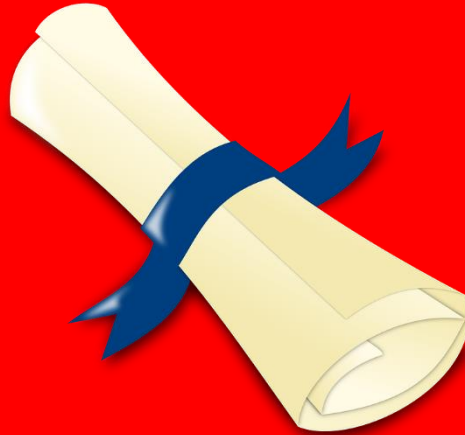

We had daisy's and watered them daily to see them grow. Summer is right around the corner, but May has been good to us!



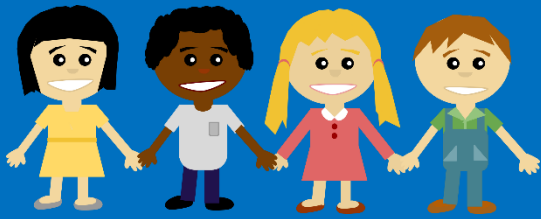

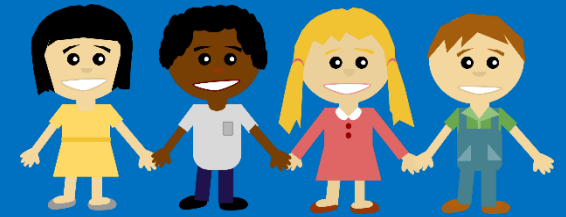
