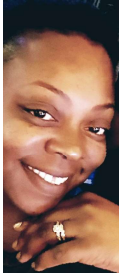

March Curriculum News

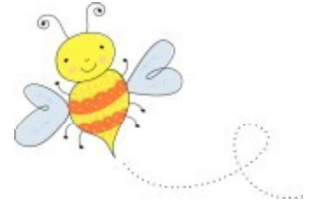
Infants

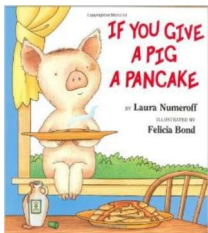
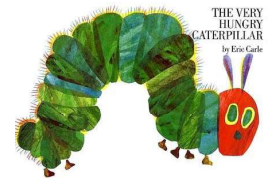

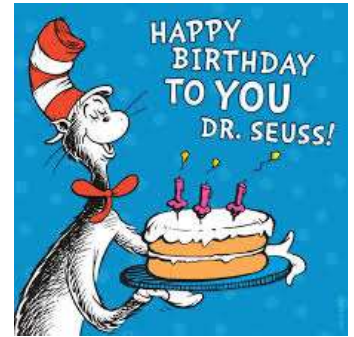
Dr. Seuss

Theodor Seuss Geisel was an American writer and cartoonist. He was most widely known for his children's books, which he wrote and illustrated under the pseudonym Dr. Seuss.

Geisel published 46 children's books, often characterized by imaginative characters, rhyme, and frequent use of anapestic meter.

He was a perfectionist in his work and would sometimes spend up to a year on a book. It was not uncommon for him to throw out 95% of his material until he settled on a theme for his book.

All month long, our little scholars will experience the great work of Dr. Seuss by learning the importance of the humor character value, creating "Seuss" Art, and listening to some of his classic stories like "Cat in the Hat", "Oh, the places we will go", "Green Eggs and Ham", and an all-time favorite, "One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish".
