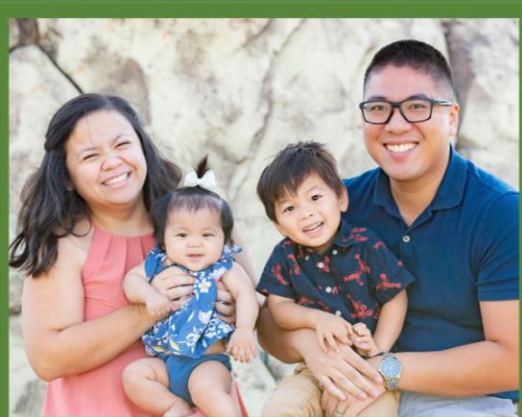

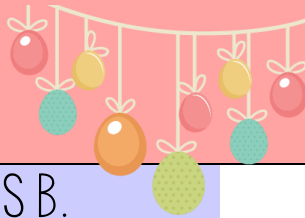


Easter Egg Hunt F.A.Q.

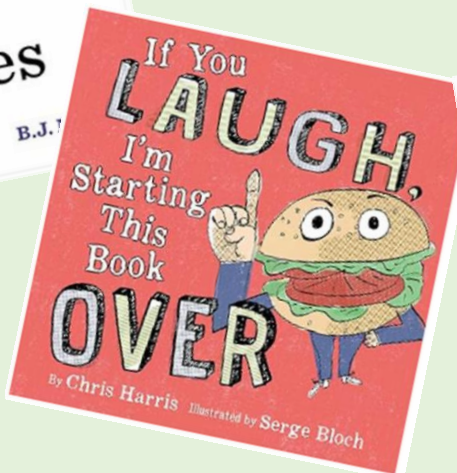

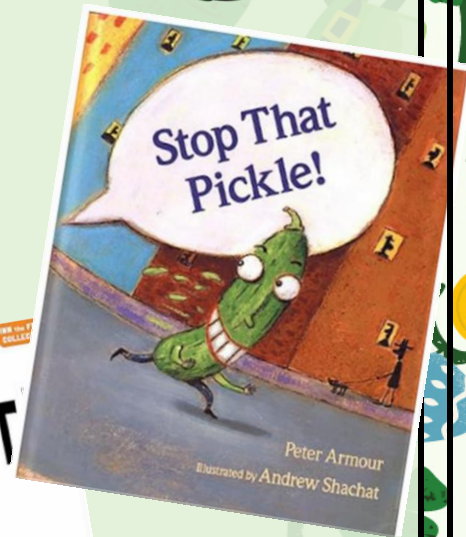
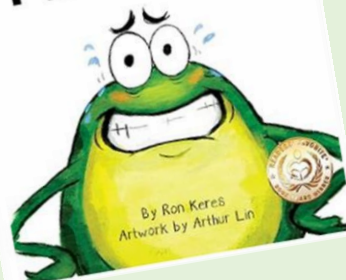
