Curriculum Overview

Infants 1-3

This month our theme is Senses. We will be focusing on the shape clover and the color green. We will be singing “Baby Bumble Bee”. Our rhyme is “Clap, Clap, Clap Your Hands”. The sing language focus word for the month is: HOT. Our Spanish word for the month is Hot/Caliente.

Toddlers

This month our theme is Fruits and Vegetables. We will be focusing on the shape clover and the color green. We will be singing “We Planted a Little Seed” and reciting “Grow Little Seed”. The sign language focus is the word hot. Our Spanish words for the month are hot/caliente, green/verde, fruit/la fruta, and vegetables/el vegetal.



Early Preschool

Theme: Foods and Nutrition

Science and Nature Focus: Farm Animals

Letters: Kk, Qq, Vv

Math: Sets 1-10 and patterning

Preschool
