Welcome to March! If you have plans to be away during Spring Break, email us by Monday, March 4th at 9 a.m. at the Director email listed above to let us know so that we can apply an Absentee Credit. We offer each child (ages 13 months and older) five weeks of Absentee Credits each year to be used for a 40% discount off of their weekly tuition. Additionally, for families who have been with us for at least one year and will be absent for an entire week, we offer for one of those weeks to be a 100% discount . Please keep in mind that any families not on Tuition Express for automatic payment withdrawal will be required to pay the discounted tuition amount at the time that the Absentee Credit form is submitted. For those School-Age children who will be joining us for Spring Break, we are looking forward to a week full of fun and special activities.

As we move towards the summer, we wanted to remind you that we will be collecting Curriculum Fees, which secure your child's spot for the Fall. Each family's Curriculum Fee will be added to their account on April 8th. If your family pays tuition via Automatic Withdrawal, the Curriculum Fee will be deducted automatically, but all other families will need to pay via check or money order by April 12th in order to secure their child's Fall enrollment. During the summer, we know that many of your families will have a change in plans for school attendance. As is always the case, we offer additional flexibility during the summer, and allow families the opportunity to spend the summer away, but reserve their child's spot for the Fall, as long as the Curriculum Fee is paid in full by April 12th. If you do not plan to have your child attend Lighthouse in the Fall, please email us by April 1st, so that we may plan accordingly and ensure a Curriculum Fee is not billed.

temperature of 100.0° or higher

fever-free for 24 hours without the use of feverreducing medication i.e. Tylenol, ibuprofen



I AM VOMITING twice within the past 24 hours

free from vomiting for at least 24 hours



I HAVE DIARRHEA three times within the past 24 hours

free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours



I HAVE A RASH body rash with itching or fever

free from rash, itching, or fever. I have been evaluated by my doctor if needed.



I HAVE HEAD LICE active head lice, nits, eggs

treated with appropriate lice treatment and cleared of any lice, nits, eggs, upon entering



I HAVE AN EYE INFECTION redness, itching, and/or crusty drainage from eye evaluated by my doctor and have a note to return to school

- If your child is sick and requires pick up, please arrange to be here within one hour. This is a state licensing requirement.
