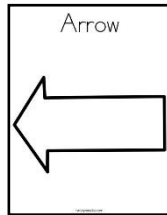
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Below is a breakdown of the monthly focus. To continue the extension of learning at home you can practice using the sign language word and point out the colors and shapes in your child's world.

RAINBOW WINDSOCK CRAFT



SUPPLIES:

- Paper cups
- Scissors
- Ribbon scraps or streamers in rainbow colors—red, orange, yellow, blue, green, and purple or rainbow- striped
- Cotton balls
- Tape/Glue

Cut equal length pieces of ribbon or streamer and glue or tape them to the top edge of the cup. These colors will be your rainbow!
 Turn the cup over and glue cotton balls to the outside of the cup. This will be your cloud!
