SCHOOL READY AND KINDER PREP

As many of you have noticed, we have been thoughtfully cross-training our teachers and assistants over the past several weeks. This intentional practice will continue as we build the strongest possible teams in preparation for two exciting developments: the creation of our new **School Ready Classroom** and the return of our **Kinder Prep Program**.

These enhancements are part of our ongoing effort to align our preschool structure with the evolving public-school model—especially as more of our students transition into **Pre-K 3** and **Pre-K 4** programs within the district. While our curriculum remains consistent, the **Squids classroom** will now serve as our final potty-training class. Children will move into our Pre-K classrooms once they are fully toilet trained. *Toilet training* means your child can independently communicate their need to use the restroom without prompting from a teacher.

We are thrilled to share the following staffing updates as we launch these new initiatives:

Ms. Marina will lead the School Readiness Program in **Squids**.

Ms. Dey will transition to Room 8 (**Whales**).

Ms. Joanna will move to Room 9 (**Dolphins**).

Room 10 will reopen as our **Kinder Prep Classroom**, designed specifically for children who will enter Kindergarten in the fall of the *following* school year.

Please note: This does *not* apply to current Dolphin students who are already set to begin Kindergarten this coming fall.

On our infant and toddler side, Rooms 1–6 will remain the same with a few exciting teacher adjustments:

Ms. Martina will become the new **Sea Horses** teacher.

Ms. Angel will take over **Sharks**.

Ms. Blake will step into the lead role in **Guppies**.

We are truly excited about these changes. Each adjustment is designed to better support the developmental needs of every age group and to strengthen the continuity of learning throughout our building. These transitions will roll out gradually over the next **3–6 months**, and we will keep you informed every step of the way.
