Activity Idea: Muddy Animal Wash

Supplies: Water, cocoa powder(may use brown paint as an alternative), plastic spoon, plastic farm animals, dish soap, round dish brushes, and containers or bowls.

Prepare the activity by filling one bowl with plastic farm animals, a small amount of water, and mix in a few scoops of cocoa powder. Fill the other sensory bin with soapy water and a dish brush. Encourage the children to take the muddy animals and wash them in soapy water and clean them with a brush.


