Hello parents and friends!

May is going to be such a busy and fun month for us here at Childrens Lighthouse. Before we get to that, I would like to take a moment to go over a few housekeeping items.

- Please make sure that you are utilizing the parking spots available. We understand that sometimes, drop off is a rush but please be courteous and make sure that you are not blocking others, the fire lanes or using the handicap spots if you do not have a sticker.
- After-Schooler parents, please make sure to call the center by 12noon to let us know if your child will not be on the bus that afternoon. We will begin enforcing the \$10.00 non-notification fee if we are not notified beforehand.
- Please make sure that you are signing in and out your child(ren) everyday. This is an important tool to ensure the safety of all the children in our care. - ♦ Also, please make sure to utilize the side door at the end of the hallway if your child's class is outside. This is to ensure that the classrooms are not disrupted.
- ♦ Tuition is due by the end of the business day every Tuesday. A late fee of \$25 will be added to the account on Wednesday and an additional \$10 each day after until the amount is paid in full.




