GLUE FALL LEAVES





DIRECTIONS:

- FOLD A SHEET OF ORANGE PAPER IN HALF AND CUT OUT A PUMPKIN OUTLINE. WHILE STILL FOLDED. CUT THE INSIDE OF THE PUMPKIN OUT AS IN THE PICTURE
- CUT OUT A GREEN LEAF AND BROWN STEM TO GI UF TO YOUR PUMPKIN
- CUT OUT A LARGE SECTION OF CONTACT PAPER AND PLACE PUMPKIN OUTLINE IN THE CENTER
- ADD LEAVES, FLOWERS, ETC. TO THE CENTER OF YOUR PUMPKIN
- COVER WITH ANOTHER SHEET OF CONTACT PAPER AND SEAL. CUT OUT AROUND PUMPKIN OUTLINE AND HANG IN YOUR WINDOW!
