Craft Corner

Did you know!: Five Fun Facts About Owls

- Because of the shape and the size of their large eyes, owls cannot move their eyes to look around.
- Female owls tend to be slightly larger than male owls.
- Owls have specialized auditory functions that help provide acoustic information to locate and pursue their prey.



Supplies Needed:

- Paper plates uncoated basic plates
- Paint we used acrylic
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Ribbon for hanging optional
- Glue Tacky Glue or hot glue

What to do:

- 1 Fold both sides of the plate in toward the center.
- 2 Then fold over the top of the plate to make the owl's head.
- 3 Now it's time to paint. Open up the plate and paint the inside. Let it dry. Then fold the plate again and paint the head and wings

If you don't have orange food coloring you can combine red and yellow.

- 4 Use either hot glue or Tacky Glue to glue the wings and head down. Then paint feathers on the body. For younger kids, the feathers can be larger. There's no wrong way to do this!
- 5 Cut out the eyes, beak, and feet from construction paper.
- TIP: Plastic caps are perfect when you need to draw a nice, round circle! I like to save plastic caps in a variety of sizes for crafting.
- 6 Glue the eyes, beak, and feet to the owl's body, and your owl craft is complete!
