Infants —Rooms 1, 2 & 3

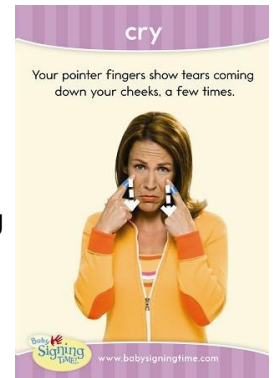
This month we will be learning about **Storybook Classics and Characters**.

We will focus on the shape **rectangle** and the color **brown**.

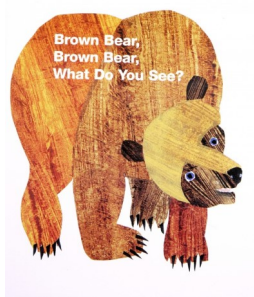
We will be singing “**Old MacDonald Had a Farm**” and “**Bumping Up and Down in My Little Red Wagon**.”

We will also be learning about the origin of **Thanksgiving** and how it evolved into the Thanksgiving holiday we celebrate today.

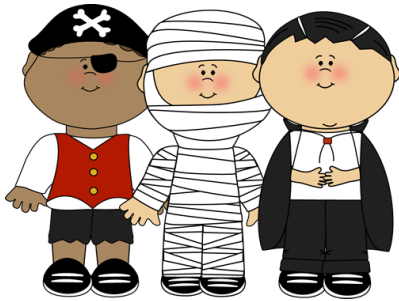

Join us for carnival games, food, and fun on Friday, November 2nd from 7pm-9pm. The cost is only **\$5 per person** and children 2 years old and under are free.

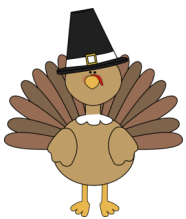
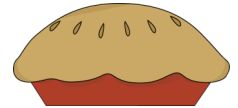
We are also hosting a **chili cook-off** so please feel free to enter your famous chili into the contest!

Join us for **Pie with Parents** on Thursday, November 15th, at 3:30pm as we celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday through tasty sweet treats!






