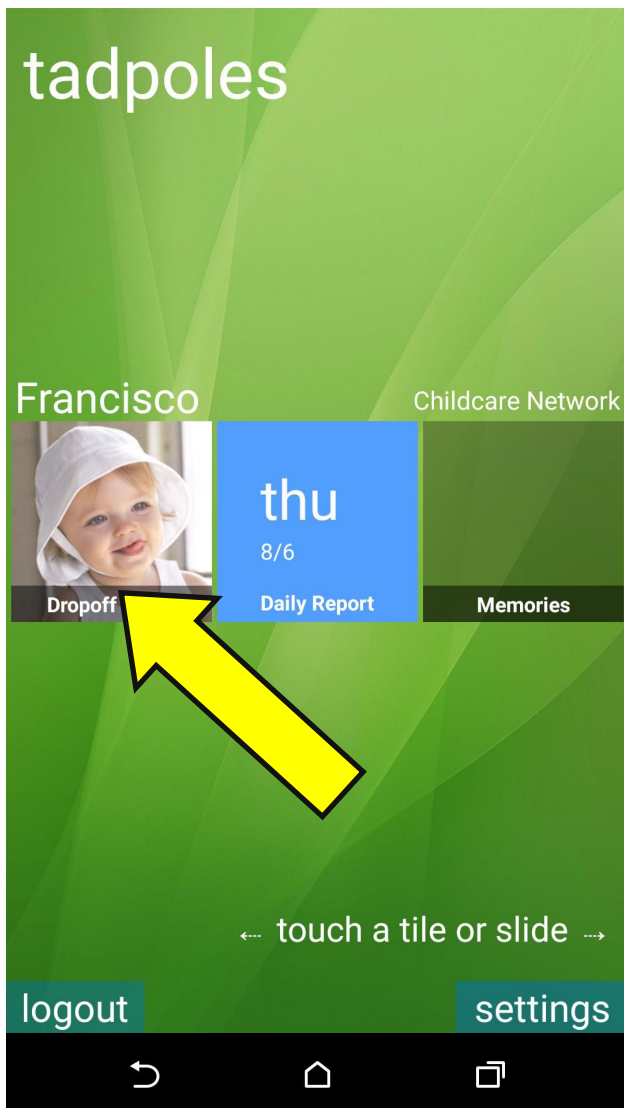




Congratulations...

DID YOU KNOW....

We encourage families to utilize the feature in Tadpoles which allows for parent-to-teacher communication! If you click on the "Dropoff Notes" button on the Tadpoles Parent App (before you drop off your child), you can add in information about your child's evening/morning, notes about missing items (like a jacket) or anything that might be helpful for your child's teacher to know! Your child's teacher can reply back to you to read in their daily report at the end of the day! Additionally, you can mark your child absent or sick for a day, set up notifications to alert you when your child has been dropped off and/or if they are not here by a certain time!
