<u>Activity Idea – Fall Colors</u>

Supplies: White paper, paint (brown, orange, red and yellow), mesh bath sponge, and shallow paint dish. Provide a shallow paint dish with dollops of each fall color. Assist the infant to repeatedly dip their sponge into the paint then stamp it onto their paper. **Inquiry Question**: What will happen if you mix the paint colors together?
