



Assessment and Understanding: At the start of the school year, we assess your child's developmental milestones, curricular goals, and general skills using anecdotal notes, work samples, and academic tests. This helps us develop a clear understanding of your child's abilities.

Building Relationships: These conferences allow us to get to know our families better. They provide an opportunity to define goals for parents and discuss how we can collaboratively build a foundation for continued learning.

Focused on the Child: The primary focus of these conferences is your child's development and academic journey. It's a time to share insights, celebrate achievements, and address any concerns.

Convenient Scheduling: Sign-up sheets are available on classroom doors, but spots fill up quickly. If you cannot attend the in-person conferences on 10/14, phone conferences are will be available the week of 11/25. We appreciate your patience as we schedule everyone for their meetings.

In-Person Interaction: All conferences are scheduled for in-person meetings and will last approximately 30 minutes. If more time is needed, we can arrange for a follow-up meeting.
