"Spooky Lava Lamp"



Materials:

1. Jar or Beaker
2. Cooking Oil
3. Water
4. Food Coloring
5. Alka Seltzer
6. Spooky Accessories



Directions:

1. Fill a jar $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way with water.
2. Fill up the rest of the jar with oil.
3. Observe what happens when you add the drops of food coloring to the oil and water mixture.
4. Add an alka seltzer tablet and watch what happens!
