As the weather changes and we get to enjoy some cooler temperatures, please check your child's cubby to make sure that they are well stocked with seasonably appropriate clothing for unexpected outfit changes.

With the change in seasons also comes "cold and flu" season and we want to make sure we are working together to do all we can to minimize the spread of illnesses. We maintain a rigorous sanitation protocol and our ZONO machine is in constant use for disinfecting throughout the day as we rotate all of the items in each classroom. Of course we know that regular handwashing is the single most important tool in staying healthy and we are diligent about doing that all day long. Please remember to take the time to wash your child's hands when you arrive in the classroom. Illnesses do occur in a group care setting and we ask for your help when your children are ill. Our Wellness Policy requires that all children with a fever of 100 or above must stay home until they have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication. We know that it can be very challenging to balance the demands of ill children with other obligations, but the spread of sickness is slowed substantially when children are not exposed to contagious illnesses. We are so thankful for your help and are hoping that all of our cooperative efforts lead to a mild winter season.
