We just wanted to say thank you for everything you are doing to make sure our school is safe. As Covid numbers rise we are doing everything possible to make sure we are keeping everyone safe. We wanted to let you know what we are doing to protect our Lighthouse family.

- All staff is wearing masks and are handwashing constantly.
- Daily wipe downs of high touch surfaces every two hours.
- DIS.IN.FX is spraying our building and playgrounds once a month and have provided a spray to treat rooms in between treatments.
- Spraying all hard surfaces and rugs every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Keeping our children that attend public school separate from Room 1-9. We are not combining into 10 at the beginning or end of the day.

We recently decided to take an additional step to limit exposure within our school by implementing our new drop off and pick up policy. Please help us by following the guidelines below.

- Children may only be dropped off between 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and picked up between 2:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Of course, there are situations that come up, so please just call.
- Drop off and pick up will take place outside of the building under the covered porch or in the front entry. The 2nd set of doors will be closed.
- On Monday a new standalone thermometer will be delivered & we will use it going forward.
- All children will continue to sanitize their hands before they are taken inside the classroom.
- A member of the leadership team will greet your child and walk them to class.
- Car seats should be left with the staff member outside to be sanitized before they are taken inside the building.
- Pick-up as in the past someone will be outside calling children's names on the walkie talkie. We will bring your kiddos to you at the door.
