## Infants/Toddlers - Rooms 1 & 3

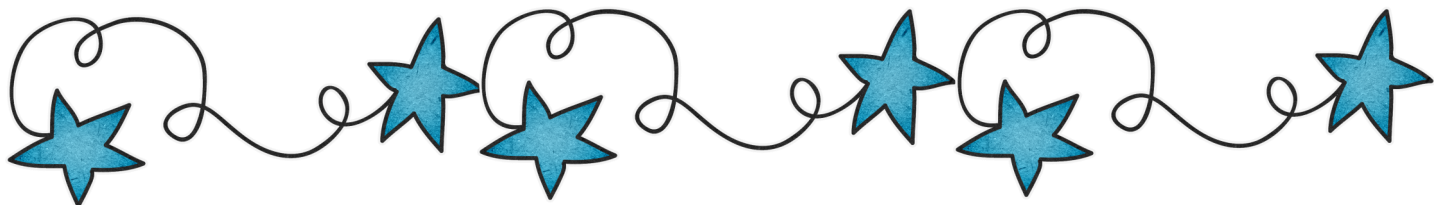
Room 1: Ms. Debra

# Director's Corner

Dear Parents,

- Although we currently offer curbside drop off/pick up OR allowing parents to come inside, with the rise of COVID cases in our area, we are going back to **curbside pickup and drop off only**. At pick up time, please make sure you have your car tag visible and make sure the front of your vehicle does not go past the flag holder.
- We have a **9:30 a.m. cut off time**. We will not accept children past 9:30 a.m. unless there is a doctors excuse. Please give us a call if your child has an appointment and will be dropped off after 9:30 a.m.
- For your child's safety, we require **closed toes shoes** in the building.
- Please sign in all medications at the front desk and leave them with management in their original packaging. We will administer medications between 11:30 A.M. – 12:00 P.M. and again between 3:30 P.M. – 4:00 P.M. Medication will only be given per the instructions on the container which will be determined by the age of the child unless instructed otherwise by a physician.
- For School-Age parents, our buses leave the center no later than 7:30 A.M. which means all morning bus riders must arrive at our center by 7:15 A.M. Additionally, please remember to call our center by 2:00 P.M. if your child will not be present on our afternoon bus run in order to avoid the **\$10.00 no call/no pick-up fee**.
- Please make sure your child has an updated enrollment and allergy sheet

**Cooperation** - the process of working together to the same end.

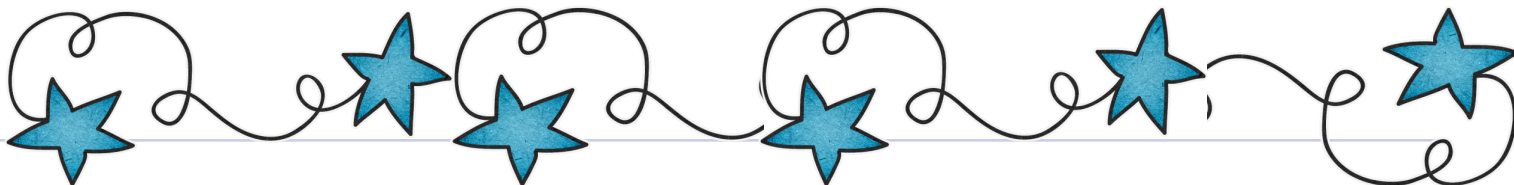
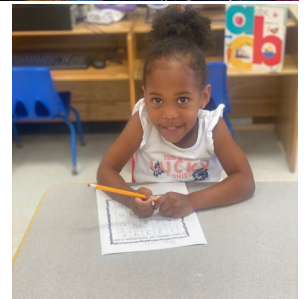
