September's Family of the Month – The Butler's

PAPER PLATE APPLE WITH WORM



Craft Supplies:

Small Paper Plate	Red Craft Paint	Small Wiggle Eyes
Stapler Paper	Jumbo Popsicle Stick	School Glue
Foam Paint Brush	Black Marker	Scissors
Green Cardstock	Brown Cardstock Paper	

Directions:

1ST have children paint their paper plate red. Squirt some paint in the center and have them to move it around with the foam paint brush.

Once done, set aside the paper plate to dry a bit.

Next grab the jumbo popsicle stick.

Glue on the small wiggle eyes and finish off with black marks all over the rest, to give the look of a worm, then set aside.

Now grab your painted paper plate and craft scissors.

Cut TWO slits in the middle of the paper plate.

Thread your popsicle stick worm through it.

Finish off your Paper Plate Apple w/Worm craft – cut out a leaf/stem out of the cardstock and staple it to the paper plate.

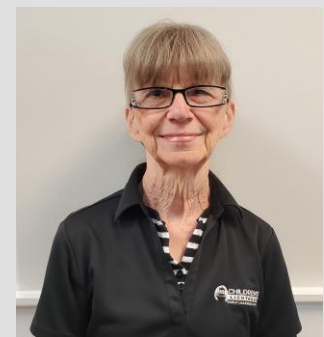
Then display proudly for all to see and enjoy!!
