As you know, math will be an important learning subject implemented each day. And, of course, you can add fun activities with your child at home. Tips and Tricks for Baby Safety

- To prevents burns, do not microwave baby's bottle. Many microwaves heat unevenly, creating "hot spots" in your baby's formula that can burn your baby's mouth.
- Keep sharp objects (knives, scissors, tools,, razors) and other hazardous items (coins, glass, object, beads, pins, medications) in a secure place out of baby's reach.
- Inspect your child's toys often. Be sure that toys are unbreakable, do
 not come apart, do not have small parts that could be chewed or broken off, are not sharp, and larger than baby's mouth.
- Install safety gates securely, in front of stairs and basement doors.
