Curriculum Highlights - August 2020

Rooms 1, 2, & 3 - The new school year has started, and we are so excited to learn! This month our theme is BIG and LITTLE and we will be focusing on the sign BIG. We will talk about the circle shape, color red, and the Spanish words "grande" and "pequeno".

<u>Room 4</u> – This month our theme is LITTLE ANIMALS and we will be focusing on the rhyme "Five Little Monkeys". We will talk about the triangle shape, color red, and the song "Pop Goes the Bunny".

<u>Room 5</u> - The theme for this month is All About Me, and the Character Value is Pride. The children will be focusing on learning about these two topics throughout the month. They will also be learning all the primary colors, circle and square shapes, letter A and the number 1, while exploring our discovery areas.
