We are so excited to welcome your family to Children's Lighthouse for our 2021-2022 school year. We cannot wait to share so many amazing experiences with your children. Whether you have been in our Lighthouse family for years or are just recently joining us, we have highlighted some information below that we hope will ease the transition process. Please know that our door is always open to share any questions or concerns.

Early Bird Breakfast

We provide cereal and milk to all children who arrive between 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. each day. For all children who arrive after 7:30 a.m., we provide a heartier full morning snack at 8:30 a.m.

Tuition and Billing

Each week tuition is billed on Monday, and payment is due by 9 a.m. on Wednesday morning. For all account balances outstanding on Wednesday after 9 a.m., a \$25 late will be assessed. Payment options include check or automatic withdrawal. Please see the front desk for a form to enroll in our automatic withdrawal option.

Absentee Credits

We offer a 40% reduced rate in tuition for five weeks each calendar year due to illnesses or vacations. Absentee Credits can be applied when the following conditions are met:

- A request via email is sent in advance of the scheduled absence
- 3 or more consecutive days are missed
- Child is over 12 months of age and enrolled full-time

Wellness Policy

Our commitment to keeping children healthy is paramount. In addition to our daily sanitation procedures in the classrooms, our ZONO machine allows an additional level of high-powered disinfecting. To prevent the spread of illnesses, we work hard to swiftly remove ill children and teachers from their peers. We ask for your partnership in keeping sick children home until they have been symptom-free or on antibiotics for 24 hours. These sicknesses include, but are not limited to, a fever of 100.0 and above, vomiting, diarrhea, and pink eye.


