Directors' Corner...

We are so excited to welcome your family to Children's Lighthouse for our 2022-2023 school year. Whether you have been in our Lighthouse family for years or are just recently joining us, we have highlighted some information below that we hope will ease the transition process. Please know that our door is always open to share any questions or concerns.

Breakfast Times

We provide cereal and milk to all children who arrive between 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. each day. For all children who arrive after 7:30 a.m., we provide a heartier full morning snack at 8:30 a.m. If your child is not in their classroom by 8:45 a.m., we will not be able to serve them a morning snack as the classrooms begin their morning routine and our kitchen manager transitions to preparing for lunch so that it is served on time to all children.

Incident Reports

All incident reports are sent digitally to parents via Tadpoles. Please acknowledge receipt of each incident report by replying "Received and read" to the email. If you have any follow-up questions for the Directors about the incident, you are welcome to include them in the email as well.

Tuition and Billing

Each week tuition is billed on Monday, and payment is due by 9 a.m. on Wednesday morning. For all account balances outstanding on Wednesday after 9 a.m., a \$25 late will be assessed. Payment options include check or automatic withdrawal. Please see the front desk for a form to enroll in our automatic withdrawal option.

Absentee Credits

We offer a 40% reduced rate in tuition for five weeks each calendar year, for children enrolled full-time who are 13+ months old, due to illnesses or vacations. Absentee Credits can be requested by sending an email for the planned absence for three of more consecutive days missed (where none of the missed days are holidays). Note: If not on automatic withdrawal for tuition, all Absentee Credits must be paid in advance.

Wellness Policy (with updated COVID-19 protocols)

Our commitment to keeping children healthy is paramount. In addition to our daily sanitation procedures in the classrooms, our ZONO machine allows an additional level of high-powered disinfecting. To prevent the spread of illnesses, we work hard to swiftly remove ill children and teachers from their peers. We ask for your partnership in keeping sick children home until they have been symptom-free or on antibiotics for 24 hours. In accordance with new CDC guidance, quarantines for COVID-19 are only required for the person who tests positive, but not for any additional family members.
