#### **Incident Reports**

All incident reports are sent digitally to parents via Tadpoles. Please acknowledge receipt of each incident report by replying "Received and read" to the email. If you have any follow-up questions for the Directors about the incident, you are welcome to include them in the email as well.

### Tuition and Billing

Each week tuition is billed on Monday, and payment is due by 9am on Wednesday morning. For all account balances outstanding on Wednesday after 9am, a \$25 late will be assessed. Payment options include check, credit card (4% fee), or automatic withdrawal. Please see the front desk for a form to enroll in our automatic withdrawal option. Please note that the new rates are now in effect.

## Absentee Credits

We offer a 40% reduced rate in tuition for five weeks each calendar year, for children enrolled full-time who are 13+ months old, due to illnesses or vacations. Absentee Credits can be requested by sending an email for the planned absence for three of more consecutive days missed (where none of the missed days are holidays).

Our theme for the month is Wonderful Me and there are so many wonderful "me's" in this class. We are excited to learn all about everyone.


We have some smelly painting coming up along with other fun things like dance parties, learning stretches, and role playing!
