Arrival Time Matters

Late arrivals disrupt learning and make it harder for your child to transition. If arriving after 10:00am, please call ahead so we can notify the teacher.

Nap Time

Avoid drop-off or pick-up between 12:30–2:30pm unless it's an emergency or pre-arranged. Interruptions during nap time are especially disruptive for younger children. Call us if you need assistance during these hours.

FOOD RESTRICTIONS

The State of Texas Childcare Licensing requires us to provide all food served to children while they are in our care. Because we are a full-service program, **outside food is not permitted** unless a doctor provides written approval and parents submit a signed acknowledgment.

We understand that some children may not eat breakfast at home or may prefer different foods; however, we have established processes for those situations. Many items brought from home contain **nuts, nut products, or added sugars**, and we cannot safely monitor outside food the way we monitor food prepared in our kitchen. For safety and compliance reasons, **outside food cannot be brought into classrooms.**

We offer cereal and milk from **6:30–7:00 a.m.**, and a second breakfast at **9:00 a.m.** Several children have severe allergies, and licensing will cite us if any child consumes food not provided by our kitchen. Families needing accommodations for allergies or eating concerns may follow our formal process.
