Solo Challenge: Balancing Machine

How good are you at balancing? Can you balance your body on one foot? Can you balance a ball on your fingertip or perhaps on a pencil? Well, for this Challenge, let's see if you can balance a craft stick on a chopstick! It might seem tricky, but it's just using basic science.

Follow the steps for creating a Balancing Machine:

- 1. Wrap a chenille stem around the bottom half of a craft stick one time, leaving a bit of space between the chenille stem and the bottom of the craft stick.
- 2. Press down the two ends of the chenille stem. Attach a clothespin to each end of the chenille stem.
- 3. Place one end of a chopstick under a book on the edge of a table, leaving most of the chopstick sticking out from under the book
- 4. Balance the bottom of the craft stick on the chopstick. *Adjust the placement of the clothespins to help it balance.
