Infant I, II, and III...

For the month of September we will be learning about the concepts Big and Little. We will talk about and show flashcards of BIG things like trucks, elephants, and buildings. We will also show small things like bugs, seeds, butterflies and birds. We will play with big and little boxes, big and little shoes, and big toys and little toys. For seasonal crafts we will be making leaves with our hands, finger print ladybugs, and handprint butterflies! Our color this month is red, our shape is circle, our song is Twinkle Twinkle Little Star, and our nursery rhyme is Little Miss Muffet. We will continue with flashcards, singing, sign language, stories, and dancing.

Toddlers...

This month we will focus on little animals! We look forward to talking about rabbits, monkeys, turtles, mice, and other tiny creatures! We will discuss what they look like, what they eat, and where they live. Some of our learning games this month include: crawling slow like turtles, washing play animals with paper towels, finger plays including "Pop Goes The Bunny", Monkeys Jumping On The Bed, and This Is My Turtle". Some of our creative art includes turtle prints, cotton ball bunnies, and animal collage. We will continue with our daily sign language, nursery rhymes, character values, shapes, colors, alphabet, and numbers. Our official color this month is red, our shape is circle, our song is Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star, and our nursery rhyme is Little Miss Muffet.

Early Preschool...

This year, your child will be learning about developing language and phonics skills with the help of many animal friends. Your children will learn to count from 1 to 30 and recognize the numbers 1-10. Coloring, painting and gluing will help develop fine motor skills, while stories, poetry, and music will aid in the development of comprehension, language, and thinking abilities. During the first few weeks, much time will be spent on helping the children adjust to the new classroom. We will instill good habits such as staying in chairs and using efficient procedures for lining up. We will learn two basic rules: raising a hand for permission to talk and going to our assigned seats or special places on the floor to sit during circle time. You can encourage your child by asking him/her about their day at school.

Preschool I and Preschool II...

This month our theme is "All about me". We will be exploring all the things that we do as a family and by ourselves. We will discover everything that our home center has for us as well as some dress-up time while we discuss our community workers and how they help our community. To go along with the theme we will talk about what makes up a family and who is in our family. Our focus this month will be on the letters Aa, Cc, Tt, and Mm. We will be creating letters by tracing and forming letters out of creative art materials (beans, scrap paper, etc). Some development goals we will be working on are to promote self confidence, to help them feel secure in their new environment, and to stress the importance of sharing and caring for others.

Pre-Kindergarten ...

This month we will be getting to know each other as our theme is "All about me". Our character value for September is pride. Our science and nature focus for the month is pets and zoo animals and apples. Your child will certainly enjoy sharing about pets as well as wild animals and some fun apple facts too. We will focus on the letters Aa, Tt, Cc, and Mm this month as well as our names. We are having a circle time regularly in both English and Spanish and all the boys and girls are doing a remarkable job. We will be adding more to each of these things as the children master the required skills. Kindly remember to collect your child's work from the take home crate every day to see your child's progress.
