Lastly, THANK YOU for entrusting us with the most important years of your child's life. If you have any questions or concerns, my door is always open!



Recipe of the Month:

Unicorn Fruit Popsicle

let the kiddos have one last taste of summer!

INGREDIENTS:

- 500 g of thick Greek Yogurt
- 4 tsp of maple syrup or honey
- 200 g of Frozen Pineapple
- · 200 g of Frozen Blueberries
- · 200 g of Frozen strawberries + raspberries
- · splash of milk



DIRECTIONS:

- mix 250g of the yogurt w/ 1 tsp of syrup or honey. spoon the yogurt mixture into an uncut piping bag. close the top of the piping bag w/ a rubber band and place it in the freezer to keep cold + frosty.
- 2. make up the fruit layers; mix the pineapple in the blender on high w/ the remaining yogurt adding a tsp of honey or syrup. mix until smooth. (feel free to add more sweetness if needed) spoon the pineapple into piping bag tie up and pop in freezer.
- 3. repeat w/ blueberries, strawberries, + raspberries.
- 4. use a popsicle mould, cut the top of piping bags, and insert layers and blobs of the different colored mixtures. put the lid on the mould.
- 5. place in the freezer for 2-3 hours or overnight.
