



Social Distancing Best Practices



- Space tables and chairs during mealtimes/learning centers to reflect 6 feet apart.
- Limit number of children to each learning center (with low numbers this should be easier to do).
- Separate children more when lining up to go outside (ensure playground area & equipment are being sanitized).
- Cots can be placed far enough apart to reflect 6ft of space or more between each child.
- Learning Wall/Circle Time can be conducted at the table for spacing.
- Calling children up one at a time for handwashing to allow for proper sanitation after each child.
- Ensuring that bathrooms are being sanitized after each use as well.
- Reminder to have kitchen manager serve from the hallway and limit exposure to classrooms, etc.
- Limit rotations throughout the building from one area to another.

Social Distancing means staying at least six feet away from one another and avoiding groups of more than 10 people.
